- 2. The charges listed are exclusive of labour, except for the Container Cranes, Straddle Carriers, Rubber Tyred Gantries, Tug "Gerry O'Sullivan" and Ringaskiddy Cranes.
- 3. Where labour is directly employed in the hire of the plant, the cost of labour plus administration charges at the appropriate rate will be charged extra where stated.
- 4. Prior to the hire of Port of Cork Company plant / equipment, the user should apply in writing to the Harbour Master on the relevant application form.
- 5. The rates listed in all Schedules are maximum rates. The Port of Cork Company may vary the rates in accordance with the Company's objectives.
- 6. The rates quoted are exclusive of V.A.T. (unless otherwise stated), which will be charged where applicable.
